Farmers Feed the World is a pilot program being developed by QUIS and funded by the Canadian Red Cross, now running since May 2016. The aim of the program is to provide information to and facilitate connections between Syrian newcomers and employers in food agriculture and food manufacturing fields, so that Syrian refugees can achieve self-sustainability and become active in their local economies

As a part of the program, QUIS will be hosting a Skills Connect Matching Event for Syrian Refugees. The event will be on April 12<sup>th</sup> in the Multipurpose Room at the Quinte Sports and Wellness Centre. The event will be from 9:00am-3:00pm and feature a variety of employers from the Quinte area looking to hire for permanent positions, with a focus on agriculture and food production. There will be a bus stopping in Kingston and Napanee to transport attendees to and from those areas, as well as one from the Toronto and Hamilton areas. Arabic interpreters will be available to facilitate brief interviews between employers and potential candidates. ## **VOLUNTEER TAX CLINICS**

Again this year, QUIS is holding volunteer income tax sessions during March and April. This is part of the Community Volunteer Income Tax Program, run through the Canada Revenue Agency, Canada's tax department.

As part of the program, newcomers to Canada can have their taxes done for free or, for the first time, do their own taxes with the supervision of a volunteer.

This year, QUIS is fortunate to have two volunteers for the program Ken Palmer and Tenzin

Wangkhang. Both of them would be happy to help you complete your tax return.

If you are over 18, a Canadian citizen, permanent resident or on a study or work permit, you need to file a tax return. Even if you had no income in 2016, it is worth doing this, in order to receive any tax credits you may be eligible for.

The deadline or filing tax returns is April 30.
